Topics to be Covered

- 1. Participating in a variety of surgical procedures in the role of the First Scrub and Second Scrub while working toward the goal of completing a minimum of 120 procedures in combination with Clinical II.
- 2. Preparation of the patient for a surgical procedure.
- 3. Preparation of surgical instruments and supplies for a surgical procedure.
- 4. Assisting other members of the surgical team as needed (i.e. circulator).
- 5. Proper cleaning of a surgical suite and surgical instruments and equipment.
- 6. Maintenance and care of instruments and surgical equipment after a surgical procedure.
- 7. Sterile processing, assembling of instrument sets, and sterile packaging techniques.
- 8. Sterile storage and distribution process.

- 11. Participate in the sterile storage and distribution process.
